

# My Visit to SeaStar at the IWK

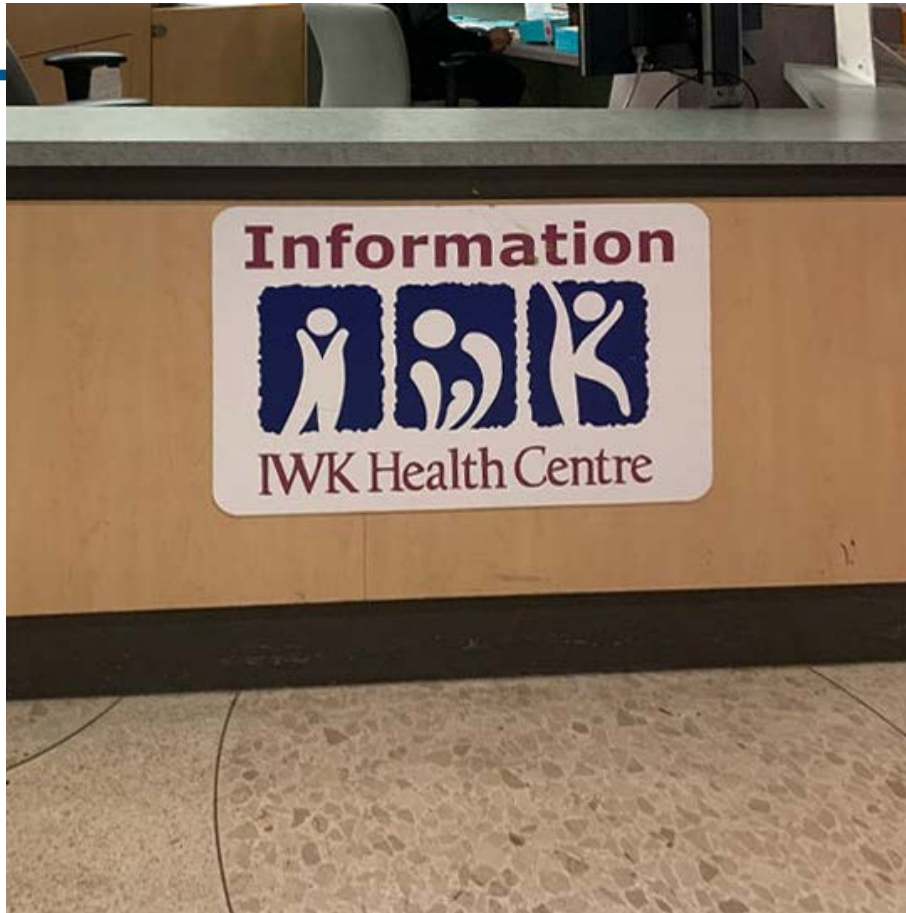


**Today we are going to the IWK.**

**I am not in any trouble. It is important that I tell the truth.**

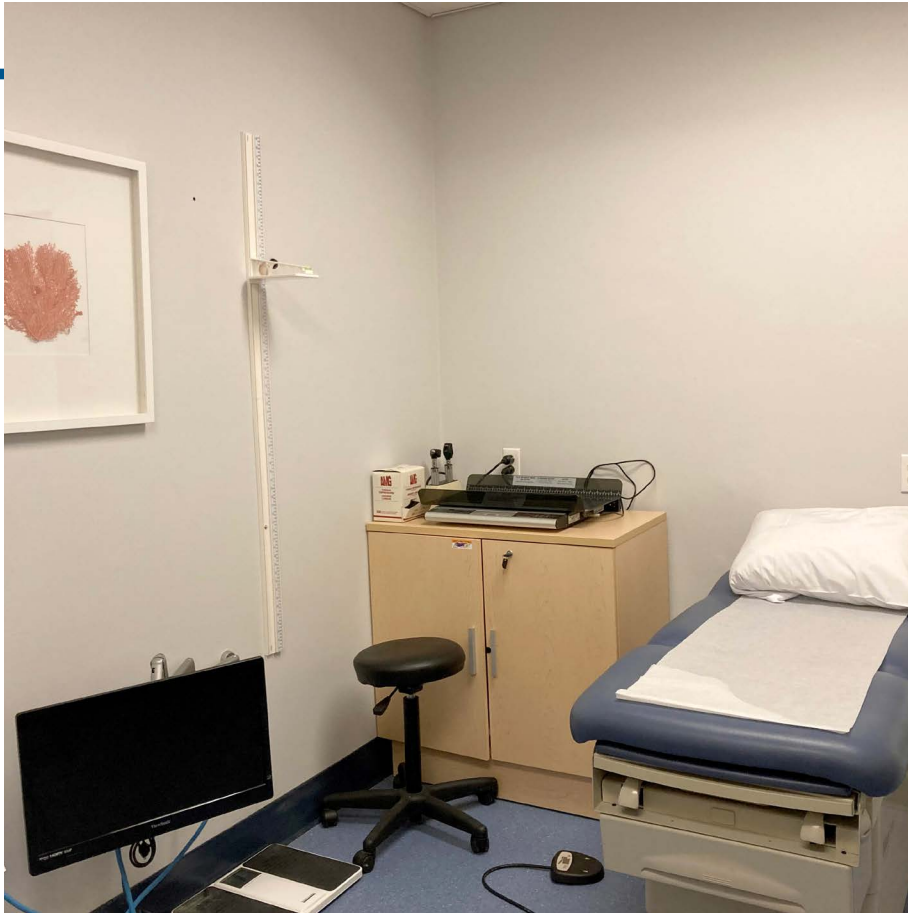


**The worker might want to talk to the people who came with me today. I will play in the waiting area while we wait for them to finish talking.**
